In 2013, a group of public defenders who loved music hosted a concert to support the fight for civil rights.

What began with \$52K raised 11 years ago has grown in 2024 to a momentous year full of firsts!

Our first \$1 million grant. Our first multi-year issue and grantee. And our first Artist in Residence, Paine the Poet, wrapped up his tenure.

What didn't change were two sold-out concerts, our free public forum, "To the Ballot Box: Our Voice, Our Vote," featuring JusticeAid "Trusted Voices," and the continuation of our monthly Justice+Arts newsletter.

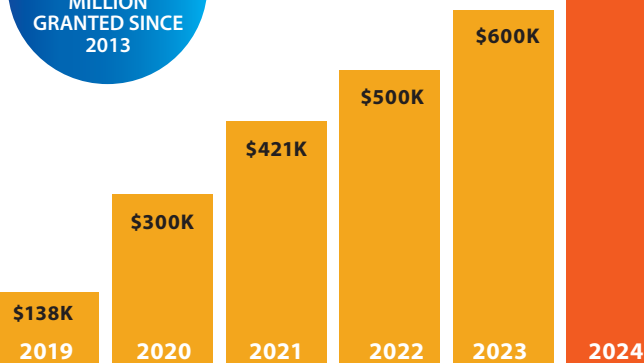

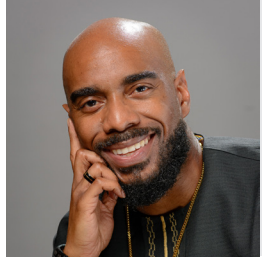

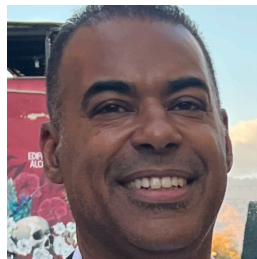
